


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Teacher Enhancement Programmes :

“A good teacher can inspire hope, ignite the imagination, and instill a love of learning.”

We believe in equipping teachers to prepare the students for the future and to update their knowledge. Indian Public School commenced the academic year 2022-2023 with a Teacher Orientation programme conducted by the Principal Mrs. Lucy. A. Cherian. The Principal focused on Curriculum and Pedagogy in schools as learning should be holistic, integrated, enjoyable and engaging. She motivated the teachers on prioritizing the students as stake holders. She stressed on the need of teachers as mentors who can address the social and emotional needs of the children. The Vice- Principal Mr. Anil Kumar announced the various teacher in-charges for the academic year.

Examinations

Periodical assessments and evaluations are conducted for the students and their progress are informed to the parents frequently. Subject enrichment activities are done by the students and teachers evaluate these as the internal assessment.

Remedial Classes:

Remedial classes are conducted every Saturday for under achievers in classes IX to XII. Special coaching and revision classes are arranged for students preparing for Board Examination. Expected toppers and above average students of class X and XII are given advanced training to ace their exams.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES AND CELEBRATIONS:

Indian Public School not only focuses upon the intellectual development of our future generation, but also takes care of their emotional and behavioural development in their early ages of development by inculcating sound moral values, responsibility and social awareness. The first ever Kuwait Cricket Junior Championship U-19 conducted by MEC study group had its finals on 1st April 2022 at Sulaibiya Cricket ground. The championship which was attended by 10 CBSE schools of Kuwait was bagged by Indian Public School with a stellar performance. Kuwait International U-19 cricket team captain, Meet Bhavsar of our school, secured the coveted titles of Man of the Match, Best Batsman and Best All Rounder in the Championship.



Indian Public School Wins Kuwait Women's Premier League Cricket Championship

Kuwait Cricket Club, emphasizing the motto, "We Believe in Our Girls", organized its first ever Kuwait Women's Premier League Cricket Championship in order to promote and support the development of Women's Cricket in Kuwait. The final was conducted on Saturday, 3rd December 2022 at Sulaibiya Cricket Ground. IPS Strikers, led by the Captain Sreya Sunil of XI C won the Group B category match played against NGIS Warriors led by Sireesha Nadimpalli. This 18-year-old prodigy had already played more than 50 International matches and has scored more than 1000 runs so far. He has already etched his name in the Guinness Book of World Records by being the Youngest International Debutant. He has received the Best Batsman award in the National Championship (2019) and Hala February Tournament (2022). He is currently Rajasthan U-19 State team player and inching closer to his dream of joining the Indian Team.



Fastest to Recite Names of Countries:

Nandhana J of Class VIII has carved her name in The India Book of Records by becoming the fastest to recite the names of Asian Countries with their capitals. She fluently recited the names of all the 48 Asian countries with their respective capitals in just 30 seconds and 77 milliseconds at the age of 13 years.


Founder's Day :
